

Safety, Health, and Wellness Policies and Procedures for Students

Safety: Students are educated annually on prevention of exposures to infectious and environmental hazards through annual updates. OSHA presentations are mandatory for all students and compliance is documented in the students personal records housed in e*Value. All students at the beginning of clinical rotations are educated on needle stick precautions and procedures prior to rotations.

Student policies on needle stick/blood borne pathogen exposures are covered in Section 8.5 of the Clinical Clerkship Manual.
